








- YTD enplanements-34% (AUG 19)

- UA passengers-18% (AUG 19)









Total Seats

National Notes


- American, Delta, Southwest, and United, have lowered their revenue expectations for 3rd quarter
 - Bump in business travel has failed to materialize
 - Business flyers probably won't be back until 2022
- Despite demand woes, airlines will fly more seats in October than at any time since the pandemic began
- SY to add another 16 aircraft to support growth mostly at MSP
- Delta capacity down 18% compared to 2019
- United capacity down 15 % compared to 2019

Local Notes

- UA steady at 3 freqs but drops 20 seats per day (150 seats)
- DL per day (exclusive use of 50 seaters)
- DL steady at 5 freqs (302 seats) per day
- Load factors on both airlines remain very strong
