# December 2021 Finance Updates & Resolutions





## Finance Updates

- Concessionaire Relief:
  - CRSSA Relief has been processed and was reimbursed to the DAA as of yesterday.
  - ARPA Relief to be approved today and submitted to the FAA this afternoon for approval.
- City Council Budget Presentation: Dec. 6th
- Concessionaire Audit:
  - Annual audit cycle to be conducted annually in the months of April June.
  - Tenants will be notified in February to provide information by 4/1/2021.
  - Memo explaining process to be sent to concessionaires by year-end.
- M&O Amendments: There were errors in our agreements approved in November (Amendments included in board packet for review)
  - DLH Grant: To be increased by \$10,892 or \$5,446 per year
  - DYT Grant: To be decreased by \$6,134 or \$3,067 per year

### Resolution A: St. Louis County Amendment

- St. Louis County agreement is for \$75,000 to support SCASD initiative to Denver.
- Amendment is to:
  - Extend the term December 31, 2023
  - To provide payment of the remaining \$50,000 when an air service agreement is in place for service

#### Resolution B: CFC Reconciliation

- Previous board approval for CFC use on terminal/parking structure debt service was \$2,360,000.
- Final reconciled CFC eligible costs as well as associated debt service is \$3,706,197.39
- Approval is requested to use CFCs to reimburse all eligible terminal and parking structure construction and financing costs in the amount of \$3,706,197.39

- 3. Resulting proportional share for each eligible concession
- 4. Resulting dollar-amount of actual rent relief provided for occupancy after March 11, 2021
- 5. Information provided on Concession Certification. If a concession is taking a second draw, the purpose(s) of that loan should be noted in the Comments column. Furthermore, taking a second draw for rent prohibits the concession from benefiting from relief under an Airport Rescue grant.
- 6. Ineligible Concessions: Hertz Rent A Car/Overland West No longer providing services. Ceased operations on June 10, 2021
- All concessionaires included in the Small Concessionaire category were placed there due to their gross receipts.
