ACDBE Program Objectives

- Ensure nondiscrimination in the award and administration of opportunites for concessions by airports receiving DOT financial assistance;
- To create a level playing field on which ACDBEs can compete fairly for opportunities for concessions;
- To ensure that the Department's ACDBE program is narrowly tailored in accordance with applicable law;
- To ensure that only firms that fully meet the part's eligibility standards are permitted to participate as ACDBEs;
- To help remove barriers to the participation of ACDBEs in opportunites for concessions at airports receiving DOT financial assistance; and
- To provide appropriate flexibilty to airports receiving COT financial assistance in establishing and providing opportunites for ACDBEs.



For Who & What are Requirements

- ACDBE means a concession that is a for-profit small business concern-
- 1. At least 51% owned by one or more individuals who are both socially and economically disadvantaged or, in the case of a corporation, in which 51% of the stock is owned by one ore more such individuals; and
- Whose management and daily business operations are controlled by one or more of the socially and economically disadvantaged individuals who own it

- Primary Airports-commercial service airports with more than 10,000 annual enplanements
- If you are a recipient that has received a grant for airport development after 1988
- Must have ACDBE Program
- Must submit annual Uniform Report to FAA
- You cannot be penalized for lack of ACDBE participation rather if you fail to administer a program in good faith
