



BE ALERT FOR AIRFIELD CHANGES!

Runway 3/21 is undergoing a lighting and signage replacement project this summer and has a planned completion date of 9/20/22. The naming convention for Runway 3/21's taxiway connectors on the Taxiway C and Taxiway D networks has changed to meet FAA standards. **Non-FAA charts may depict these taxiway name changes before the FAA's Airport Diagram, which will show these name changes on 9/8/22.**

TAXIWAY CONNECTORS HAVE BEEN RENAMED

FAA guidance requires taxiway connectors to be sequenced alpha numerically from runway end to runway end to provide enhanced situational awareness for pilots, controllers and other aircraft. Each taxiway connector, should have its own alpha numeric name. The taxiway connectors for Runway 3/21 on the Taxiway C and Taxiway D networks have been updated to meet standards.

1. Updated lighting and signage on Runway 3/21

The lighting and signage on Runway 3/21 has been updated to medium intensity LED lights and signs. Additionally, the REILs on both ends of Runway 3 and Runway 21 have been replaced.

2. Taxiway C Naming Convention Changes

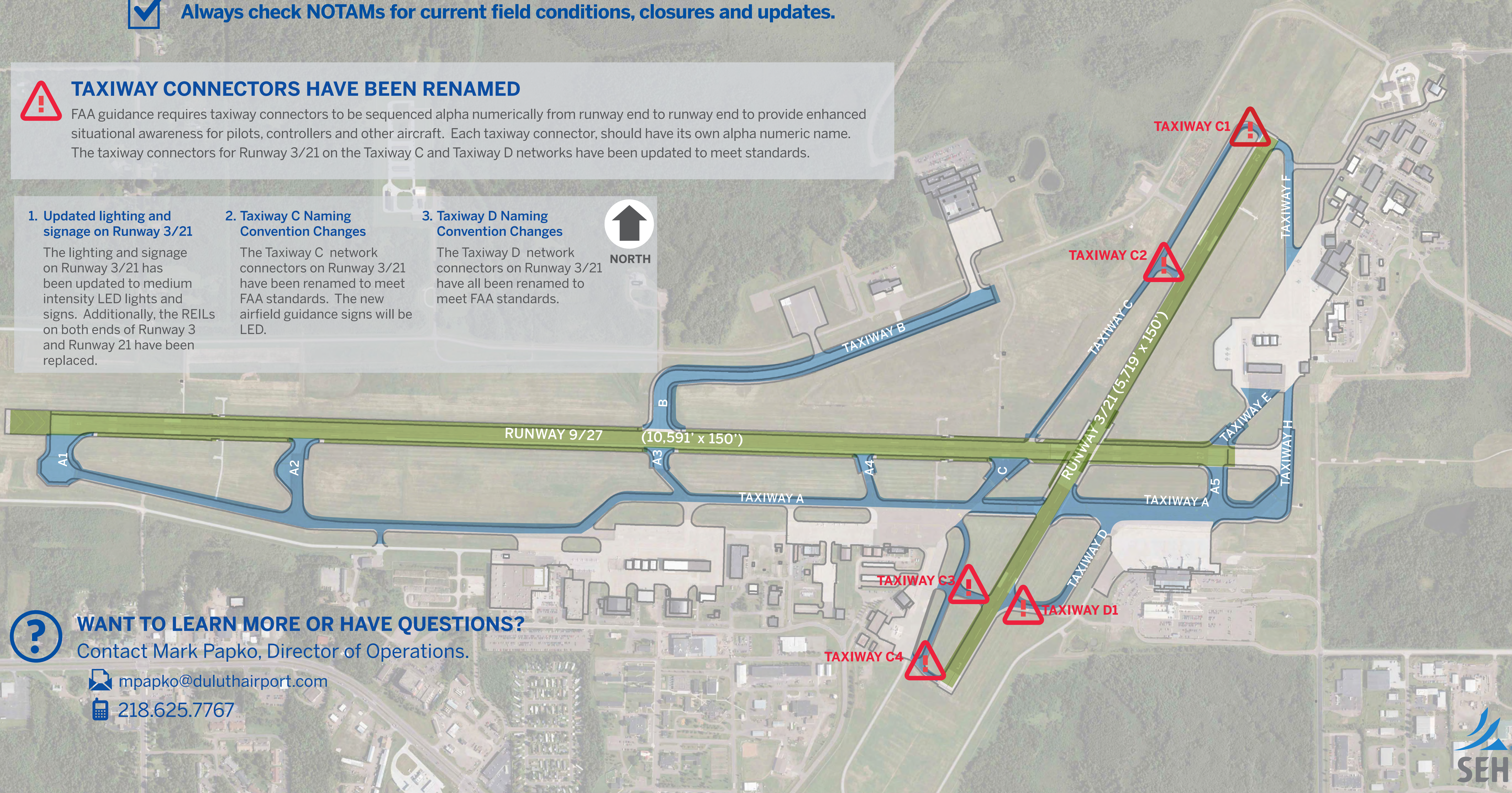
The Taxiway C network connectors on Runway 3/21 have been renamed to meet FAA standards. The new airfield guidance signs will be LED.

3. Taxiway D Naming Convention Changes

The Taxiway D network connectors on Runway 3/21 have all been renamed to meet FAA standards.
