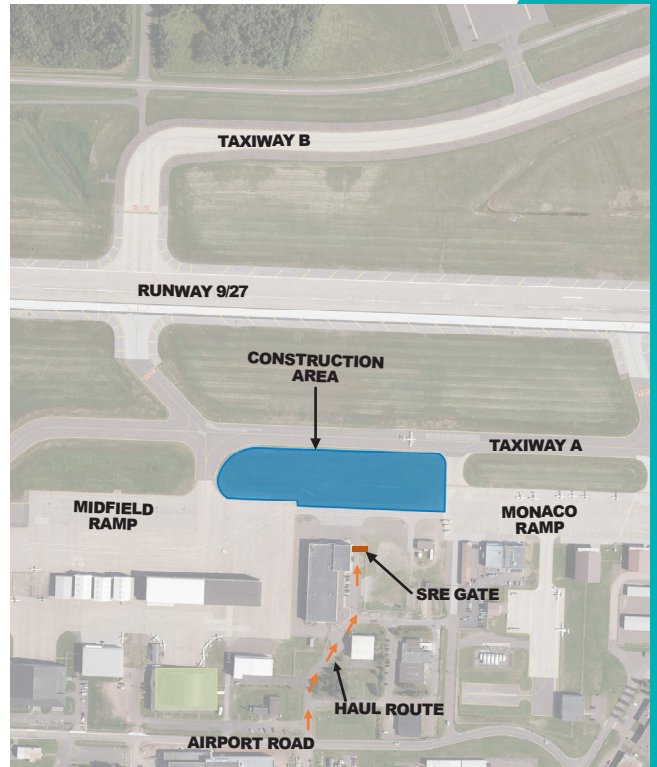
DULUTH INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

TAXIWAY A RECONSTRUCTION (PHASE 2 AND PHASE 4)

PROJECT BACKGROUND

The airport will be completing the majority of Phase 2 and Phase 4 in the Summer of 2023. However, the contractor will begin preliminary work of these projects in October of 2022. The contractor anticipates to begin on October 3rd and will be installing a portion of the new storm sewer system, as well as excavating and backfilling a section of the new expanded apron area, which will connect the midfield ramp and Monaco ramp.

There will be construction vehicle traffic utilizing the SRE gate while this work is completed this fall.
